



Site Regulations

Neuschwanstein Castle is a monument of special historical significance. The entire complex is therefore under a preservation order and is intended to ensure the quiet relaxation of each individual. You are therefore requested to respect the castle and grounds and avoid any disturbance. Special consideration must also be given to the animal and plant species found here.

The following is not permitted:

1. Leaving the paths on the entire complex or leaving the marked paths during a castle tour.
2. Allowing dogs to run free (dogs must be kept on a short lead and dog faeces must be disposed of in the waste bins provided) or bringing dogs and other animals into the castle building.
3. Driving vehicles or small electric vehicles (segways, e-scooters, etc.) or riding bikes on the footpaths on the entire complex.
4. Using sound transmission or playback devices, musical instruments or creating noise pollution of any kind.
5. Playing ball games or other sports if this endangers or disturbs others.
6. Damaging or soiling facilities, structures, plants or any other items or removing them from their locations.
7. Making open fires, having barbeques or smoking or creating any other fire hazards.
8. Camping, pitching tents, staying overnight and setting up leisure and camping furniture.
9. Leaving rubbish anywhere on the property.
10. Drinking alcohol if this causes undue disturbance to others.
11. Engaging in commercial trade, services, events and advertising of any kind, organising collections, begging or distributing or affixing printed matter (posters, signs, stickers, etc.) without permission.
12. Taking photographs or filming for commercial purposes without permission.
13. Launching or landing aircraft, such as drones, or flying them over the property without permission.
14. Carrying and bringing in potentially dangerous items (such as weapons, explosive or flammable materials, knives, tools, scissors, pepper sprays and glass bottles, etc.).
15. Carrying and bringing in bulky items (such as pushchairs or baby carrier backpack) or luggage into the castle building.

You enter the premises at your own risk; no liability is accepted for accidents of any kind.

Any instructions given by the supervisory staff or the local security service must be strictly followed at all times on the entire complex and especially in the castle building. Compliance with the site regulations will also be ensured by means of controls; the right to carry out bag checks remains reserved. Anyone who refuses to undergo a check will forfeit the right to visit the castle building and will be expelled from the property.
